

¹RESIGNATION OF MEMBERS OF STANDING COMMITTEES OF ²[ZILLA PRAJA PARISHADS]

[G.O.Ms.No. 239, Panchayati Raj Rural Development & Relief (MDL-II), 21st April, 1995]

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 268 of the Andhra Pradesh Panchayat Raj Act, 1994 (Act No. 13 of 1994), the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following rules relating to resignation of Members of Standing Committees of ³[Zilla Praja Parishad].

RULE

Any Member of the Standing Committee of ³[Zilla Praja Parishad] may resign his office as such member by giving notice in writing to the ³[Zilla Praja Parishad]. Except in a case where the person resigning delivers the notice of resignation personally to the Chief Executive Officer, the Chief Executive Officer of the ³[Zilla Praja Parishad] shall, on receipt of a notice of resignation, obtain confirmation from the person concerned as to its genuineness. A resignation delivered personally or confirmed as aforesaid, shall take effect on the from the date on which the notice was received.

⁴RESIGNATION OF SARPANCH, UPA-SARPANCH AND MEMBERS OF GRAM PANCHAYAT - PRESIDENT, VICE-PRESIDENT OR MEMBER OR CO-OPTED MEMBER OF ⁵[MANDAL PRAJA PARISHAD] AND CHAIRMAN, VICE-CHAIRMAN OR MEMBER OR CO-OPTED MEMBER OF ³[ZILLA PRAJA PARISHAD]

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 268 read with sub-section (1) of Section 23 and Sections 157 and 185 of the Andhra Pradesh Panchayat Raj Act, 1994 (Act No. 13 of 1994), the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following rules relating to resignation of Sarpanch, Upa-Sarpanch, or member of Gram Panchayat; President, Vice-President and an elected member, or Co-opted member of ⁵[Mandal Praja Parishad] and Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and an elected member or Co-opted member of ³[Zilla Praja Parishad].

Rules

PART - I

Resignation of Members, Upa-Sarpanch or Sarpanch of Gram Panchayats

(1) Any member or the Upa-Sarpanch may resign his office by giving a notice in writing:

- (i) in a case where the Gram Panchayat is within the jurisdiction of a [Mandal Praja Parishad] to the [Mandal Praja Parishad, Development Officer of the [Mandal Praja Parishad] and
- (ii) in other cases, to the Divisional Panchayat Officer having jurisdiction over the Gram Panchayat.

Except in a case where the person resigning delivers the notice of resignation personally to the [Mandal Praja Parishad] Development Officer or to the Divisional Panchayat Officer as the case may be the said officer shall, on receipt of such notice obtain confirmation from the person concerned as to its genuineness. The resignation delivered personally or confirmed as aforesaid shall take effect on and from the date on which the notice was received by the said officer.

- (2) The Sarpanch may resign his office by giving a notice in writing to the Gram Panchayat. Such resignation shall take effect from the date on which it is placed before a meeting of the Gram Panchayat :

Provided that if, in the opinion of the Sarpanch a meeting of the Gram Panchayat cannot be convened immediately for the purpose, he may resign his office by giving such notice to the District Panchayat Officer, and on receipt thereof the District Panchayat Officer shall, except where it is delivered to him by the Sarpanch personally obtain his confirmation from the Sarpanch as to its genuineness. A resignation delivered personally or confirmed as aforesaid shall take effect on and from the date on which the notice was received by the District Panchayat Officer.

PART -II

Resignation of President, Vice-President, an Elected Member or Co-opted Member of [Mandal Praja Parishad]

The President, Vice-President or a member or Co-opted Member specified in sub-section (1) of Section 149 may resign his office as such President, Vice-President an elected Member or Co-opted Member of [Mandal Praja Parishad] by giving notice in writing to the Chief Executive Officer, [Zilla Praja Parishad]. Except in a case where the person resigning delivers the notice of resignation personally to the Chief Executive Officer, [Zilla Praja Parishad], the Chief Executive Officer shall on receipt of a notice of resignation, obtain confirmation from the person concerned as to its genuineness. A resignation delivered personally or confirmed as aforesaid shall take effect on and from the date on which the notice was received.

PART-III

Resignation of Chairman, Vice-Chairman, an Elected Member or Co-opted Member

The Chairman, Vice-Chairman, an elected Member or Co-opted Member specified in sub-section (3) of Section 177, may resign his office as such Chairman, Vice-Chairman or elected Member or Co-opted Member by giving notice in writing to the District Collector. Except in a case where the person resigning delivers the notice of resignation personally to the District Collector, the District Collector shall, on receipt of a notice of resignation, obtain confirmation from the person concerned as to its genuineness. A resignation delivered personally or confirmed as aforesaid shall take effect on and from the date on which the notice was received.
