RULES RELATING TO ISSUE OF LICENCES FOR REARING PIGS  
AND DOGS WITHOUT LICENCE FEE AND DESTRUCTION OF  
UNLICENCED PIGS AND DOGS.

[ G.O.Ms. No. 345, Panchayati Raj Rural Development & Relief (Panchayats  
& Relief Department, III), 14th August, 1996. ]

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 268  
read with section 92 and clause (xxi) of section 46 of the Andhra Pradesh  
Panchayat Act, 1994 (Act 13 of 1994), the Governor of Andhra Pradesh  
hereby makes the following rules relating to issue of licences for rearing of  
pigs and Dogs.

RULES

1. Within ten days from the commencement of the financial year every  
person who owns or is in charge of any pig or dog shall apply to the execu-  
tive authority for the grant or renewal of the licence and the disc on free  
of cost.

2. (1) A Gram Panchayat may give a public notice under section -92 of the aforesaid Act that unlicensed pigs and Dogs found straying in a public place within the limits of a gram panchayat will be destroyed after the expiry of a period of three days from the date of the notice. When such notice is given, any person may destroy in any manner, not inconsistent with the terms of the notice, any unlicensed pigs and dogs found straying within any such public place.

(2) Any pig or dog seized under sub-rule (1) above shall before being destroyed be detained. Such detention shall ordinarily be for forty eight hours but may extend to such longer period as the executive authority may consider necessary.

(3) when a pig or Dog is seized, the executive authority shall, as soon as it is possible, intimate the person, who owns or is in charge of such Pig or Dog of its detention and the period within which it should be removed, on issue of the licence, if not already issued, with a penalty of Rs. 1 - and Rs. 5 - respectively for every twenty four hours of its detention or part here of :

3. (1) On payment of the Penalty or other charges specified in rule 2, the Pigs or Dogs shall be returned to the person who owns or is in charge of such Pig or Dogs. In default of such payment within the period specified in sub-rule (3) of rule 2, the executive authority shall sell the pig or Dog in public auction after giving Public notice by means:-

(a) Affixing a copy of the notice in some conspicuous places such as:-

(i) the office of the Gram Panchayat.

(ii) the chavadi or chavadis, if any, in the village

(b) beat of Tom-Tom in the village.

(2) The sale proceeds shall be credited to the gram panchayat fund. If no price could be secured for any Pig or Dog in such auction sale, the Executive authority shall cause the pig or Dog to be destroyed.

(3) Destruction of Pig and Dog shall be by electrocution or in a lethal chamber or any other methods in accordance with the rules issued by public health authorities, if any.

(4) the destruction of stay pigs or dogs in gram panchayat shall be at the rate fixed by District Collector (Pt.wing) for such destruction in

the district and such rates so fixed by District Collector (Pan. Wing) to be applicable throughout the District shall be in force for a period of three (3) years.

(5) Every licence granted under rule 1, shall be entered in a register to be opened for the purpose and it shall contain the name and address of the person who owns or is in charge of the pig or Dog and other particulars of the pig or Dog, the number and date of issue of the licence and the amount collected by way of penalty or other charges mentioned in the foregoing rules.

(6) The executive authority shall maintain a separate register showing the description of the pig or Dog seized, the time of its seizure, the name, and address of the person who owns or is in charge of pig or Dog the penalties and other charges collected, if any date of such collection, the time, and the date of the release of the Pig or Dog.
