**ORDER:**

**Background:**

1. Constitution 73<sup>rd</sup> Amendment provides for strengthening and revitalizing the Panchayat Raj Institutions so that they can subserve the needs of the teeming millions that live in the rural areas. To achieve these objectives 73<sup>rd</sup> Amendment Act has provided for the devolution of powers and responsibilities to Panchayat Raj Institutions to enable them to function as Institutions of Self-Government with respect to;

- a. The preparation of plans for economic development and social justice;
- b. The implementation of schemes for economic development and social justice as may be entrusted to them including those in relation to the matters listed in the Eleventh Schedule.

2. Towards this end, the Government of Andhra Pradesh has enacted APPR Act 1994 (Act 13 of 1994), reflecting the spirit of the Constitutional mandate. The Ministry of Panchayat Raj, Government of India held Seven Round Table conferences to arrive at a blue print for effective devolution of powers to Panchayat Raj Institutions. To start with, the Government of Andhra Pradesh have identified 10 core subjects to be devolved to the PRIs by demarcating operational responsibility basing on the subsidiarity principle.

3. The Government have constituted a Task force Committee headed by the Special Chief Secretary to Government to review the functioning of existing systems of the line departments and prepare proposals with regard to the powers and functions to be devolved to the PRIs based on activity mapping. The Government considered the recommendations of Task Force Committee.

**Functions to be devolved:**

4. The Government after careful consideration of recommendations of the Task Force and supersession of the orders issued in the G.O's 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> read above hereby devolves the following functions along with funds to Panchayat Raj Institutions in respect of Agriculture Department.

**a. Social and Water Conservation – water shed Development**

**b. Risk Management – Natural calamities**

**c. Incentive Awards**

5. The Panchayat Raj Institutions shall prepare and approve the annual action plan for all plan schemes of the above activities devolved to the Panchayat Raj Institutions. The demarcation of functions among PRIs is mentioned in the Annexure to this order.

**Release of Funds:**

6. Budget Release Orders will be issued from Finance Department in the name of concerned Head of Department. The funds for activities devolved to PR Institutions, shall be adjusted to the PD accounts of concerned PR Institutions i.e., Zilla Parishad / Mandal Parishad / Gram Panchayat. These funds shall be utilized under supervision of the Head of the Department.

**Accounting and Auditing**

7. The Panchayat Raj Institutions shall be responsible for proper utilization, accountability, auditing and reconciliation of the funds transferred to them. Panchayat Raj Institutions shall issue utilization certificate to this Department. For this purpose, Government accounting system as detailed in G.O. Ms. No.172, Panchayat Raj & Rural Development (Acts) Dept., dated 16.05.2005 will be followed by the Panchayat Raj Institutions in respect of funds released for the devolved activities.

## **Capacity Building**

8. AP Academy of Rural Development will undertake capacity building for PR Institutions for accounting, auditing, reconciliation and other related aspects.
9. The Commissioner and Director of Agriculture, Hyderabad shall prepare the relevant training materials regarding the schemes under implementation regarding the devolved functions and will undertake capacity building for PR Institutions in these areas in coordination with AP Academy of Rural Development.
10. Functionaries concerned shall report to the respective PRIs in respect of the above devolved functions.
11. The Panchayat Raj Institutions shall strive for system improvements and foster better relations between the stakeholders and service departments and take steps to achieve convergence of schemes/activities for filling the gaps in delivery of services efficiently.
12. All existing instructions/rules/orders of the department shall be translated into Telugu and circulate to all elected representatives.
13. The Commissioner and Director of Agriculture, A.P., Hyderabad is requested to take necessary action accordingly.

To achieve these objectives 73<sup>rd</sup> Amendment Act has provided for the devolution of powers and responsibilities to Panchayat Raj Institutions to enable them to function as Institutions of Self-Government with respect to;

- a. The preparation of plans for economic development and social justice;
- b. The implementation of schemes for economic development and social justice as may be entrusted to them including those in relation to the matters listed in the Eleventh Schedule.

Towards this end, the Government of Andhra Pradesh has enacted APPR Act 1994 (Act 13 of 1994), reflecting the spirit of the Constitutional mandate. The Ministry of Panchayat Raj, Government of India held Seven Round Table conferences

to arrive at a blue print for effective devolution of powers to Panchayat Raj Institutions. To start with, the Government of Andhra Pradesh have identified 10 core subjects to be devolved to the PRIs by demarcating operational responsibility basing on the subsidiarity principle.

The Government have constituted a Task force Committee headed by the Special Chief Secretary to Government to review the functioning of existing systems of the line departments and prepare proposals with regard to the powers and functions to be devolved to the PRIs based on activity mapping. The Government considered the recommendations of Task Force Committee.

## **2.Function to be devolved**

The Government after careful consideration of recommendations of the Task Force, and in supersession of the orders issued in GO first and second read above and in partial modification of the orde4rs issued in GO third read above, hereby devolve the powers to the Panchayat Raj Institutions, in respect of Fisheries sector ( except statutory, regulatory and scientific functions)

- a. Beneficiary Oriented Schemes.
- b. Implementation of Welfare schemes for fishermen.

The amount realized on lease/auction of fishing rights in the tanks/reservoirs as per the procedure laid out in the G.O. third read above, shall be apportioned by the Fisheries Department in the following ratio.

The Panchayat Raj Institutions will prepare and approve the Annual Action Plan for all plan schemes of the above activities devolved to the Panchayat Raj Institutions. The demarcation among Panchayat Raj Institutions is mentioned in the annexure to this order (along with funds.)

Budget Release Orders will be issued form Finance Department in the name of the Commissioner of Fisheries. The funds for activities devolved to PR Institutions, shall be adjusted to the PD accounts of concerned PR Institutions i.e., Zilla Parishad / Mandal Parishad / Gram Panchayat. These funds shall be utilized under supervision of the Commissioner of Fisheries.

#### **4.Accounting and Auditing**

The Panchayat Raj Institutions shall be responsible for proper utilization, accountability, auditing and reconciliation of the funds transferred to them. Panchayat Raj Institutions shall issue utilization certificate to this Department. For this purpose, Government accounting system as detailed in G.O. Ms. No.172, Panchayat Raj & Rural Development (Acts) Dept., dt: 16.05.2005 will be followed by the Panchayat Raj Institutions in respect of funds released for the devolved activities.

#### **5.Capacity Building**

AP Academy of Rural Development will undertake capacity building for PR Institutions for accounting, auditing, reconciliation and other related aspects.

The Commissioner of Fisheries shall prepare the relevant training materials regarding the schemes under implementation regarding the devolved functions and will undertake capacity building for Panchayat Raj Institutions in these areas in coordination with AP Academy of Rural Development.

Functionaries concerned shall report to the respective Panchayat Raj Institutions in respect of the above devolved functions.

#### **6.General Instructions**

The Panchayat Raj Institutions are empowered to review, inspect and monitor the institutions of the Department of Fisheries. Whenever, they inspect an institution and suggest improvements, the authorities of the Department of Fisheries in that institution shall be responsible to send an Action Taken Report to those Panchayat Raj Institutions.

The Panchayat Raj Institutions shall strive for system improvement and foster better relations between the stakeholders and service departments and take steps to achieve convergence of schemes/activities for filling the gaps in delivery of services efficiently.

All existing instructions/rules/orders of the department shall be translated into Telugu and circulate to all elected representatives.

The Commissioner of Fisheries, Hyderabad is requested to take necessary action accordingly.

- e. Construction and Maintenance of buildings
- f. Regulation of private Livestock farms
- g. Slaughter houses
- h. Credit facilitation
- i. Capacity building of farmers

5. The Panchayat Raj Institutions prepare and approve the annual action plan for all plan schemes of the above activities devolved to the Panchayat Raj Institutions. The demarcation of functions among PRIs is mentioned in the Annexure – I and funds allocation is mentioned in Annexure – II to this order.

6. The statutory, regulatory and scientific functions like preventive and curative health care and productivity enhancement functions shall continue to be with Animal Husbandry Department as they cannot be restricted to territorial boundaries.

#### **Release of Funds**

7. Budget Release Orders will be issued form Finance Department in the name of concerned Head of Department. The funds for activities devolved to PR Institutions, shall be adjusted to the PD accounts of concerned PR Institutions i.e., Zilla Parishad / Mandal Parishad / Gram Panchayat. These funds shall be utilized under supervision of the Head of the Department.

#### **Accounting and Auditing**

8. The Panchayat Raj Institutions shall be responsible for proper utilization, accountability, auditing and reconciliation of the funds transferred to them. Panchayat Raj Institutions shall issue utilization certificate to this Department. For this purpose, Government accounting system as detailed in G.O. Ms. No.172, Panchayat Raj & Rural Development (Acts) Dept., dt: 16.05.2005 will be followed by the Panchayat Raj Institutions in respect of funds released for the devolved activities.

#### **Capacity Building**

9. AP Academy of Rural Development will undertake capacity building for PR Institutions for accounting, auditing, reconciliation and other related aspects.

10. HOD concerned shall prepare the relevant training materials regarding the schemes under implementation regarding the devolved functions and will undertake capacity building for Panchayat Raj Institutions in these areas in coordination with AP Academy of Rural Development.

**General Instructions**

11. Functionaries concerned shall report to the respective PRIs in respect of the above devolved functions.

12. The Panchayat Raj Institutions are empowered to review, inspect and monitor the above devolved activities of Animal Husbandry Department (as mentioned at Para 4) at their respective levels. Whenever they inspect an institution and suggest improvements, the authorities of the department concerned shall be responsible to send an Action Taken Report to those Panchayat Raj Institutions. However, the appointing the disciplinary authority continues to be with the Animal husbandry department. The existing drawing the disbursing system of salaries to the staff by Animal Husbandry Department shall continue.

13. The Panchayat Raj Institutions shall strive for system improvements and foster better relations between the stakeholders and service departments and take steps to achieve convergence of schemes/activities for filling the gaps in delivery of services efficiently.

14. All existing instructions/rules/orders of the department shall be translated into Telugu and circulate to all elected representatives.

15. In respect of all, technical matters, the departmental norms and specifications as prescribed by the Head of the Department shall be adhered to and the Joint Director (AH shall be taking instructions only from the Head of Department in all such matters.

16. The Director of Animal Husbandry shall take necessary action accordingly.

**ORDER :**

Constitution 73<sup>rd</sup> Amendment provides for strengthening and revitalizing the Panchayat Raj Institutions so that they can subserve the needs of the teeming millions that live in the rural areas. To achieve these objectives 73<sup>rd</sup> Amendment Act has provided for the devolution of powers and responsibilities to Panchayat Raj Institutions to enable them to function as Institutions of Self-Government with respect to;

- a. the preparation of plans for economic development and social justice;
- b. the implementation of schemes for economic development and social justice as may be entrusted to them including those in relation to the matters listed in the Eleventh Schedule.

2. Towards this end, the Government of Andhra Pradesh has enacted APPR Act 1994 (Act 13 of 1994), reflecting the spirit of the Constitutional mandate. The Ministry of Panchayat Raj, Government of India held Seven Round Table conferences to arrive at a blue print for effective devolution of powers to Panchayat Raj Institutions. To start with, the Government of Andhra Pradesh have identified 10 core subjects to be devolved to the PRIs by demarcating operational responsibility basing on the subsidiarity principle.

3. The Government have constituted a Task force Committee headed by the Special Chief Secretary to Government to review the functioning of existing systems of the line departments and to finalize the powers and functions to be devolved to the PRIs based on activity mapping. The Government considered the recommendations of Task Force Committee.

4. The Government after careful consideration of recommendations of the Task Force hereby devolves the following functions to PRIs in respect of Rural Water Supply.

- a. Maintenance of Rural Water Supply Schemes with assistance of Rural Water Supply Engineering Department
- b. Participation in Planning for new drinking water schemes
- c. Promotion of Household connections
- d. Creating awareness through Training Programmes, Seminars and IEC activities on Health Hygiene and safe Drinking Water /
- e. Review the water testing reports and Monitor the Quality of Drinking Water
- f. Planning, Implementation and monitoring of Total Sanitation

5. The Panchayat Raj Institutions prepare and approve the annual action plan for all plan schemes of the above activities devolved to the Panchayat Raj Institutions. The demarcation of functions among PRIs is mentioned in the Annexure to this order. Funds to the tune of Rs.310 crores on annual basis is being devolved to Panchayat Raj Institutions for operation and Maintenance of water supply schemes and sanitation activities. However, annual allocation may vary depending on the priorities.

**Release of Funds**

6. Budget Release Orders will be issued from Finance Department in the name of concerned Head of Department. The funds for activities devolved to PR Institutions, shall be either adjusted to the PD accounts of concerned PR Institutions i.e., Zilla Parishad / Mandal Parishad / Gram Panchayat., The funds meant for operation and Maintenance of Rural Water Supply Schemes shall be released after countersignature of the concerned Assistant Engineer / Assistant Executive Engineer.

**Accounting and Auditing**

7. The Panchayat Raj Institutions shall be responsible for proper utilization, accountability, auditing and reconciliation of the funds transferred to them. Panchayat Raj Institutions shall issue utilization certificate to this Department. For this purpose, Government accounting system as detailed in G.O. Ms. No.172, Panchayat Raj & Rural Development (Acts) Dept., dt: 16.05.2005 will be followed by the Panchayat Raj Institutions in respect of funds released for the devolved activities.

8. AP Academy of Rural Development will undertake capacity building for PR Institutions for accounting, auditing, reconciliation and other related aspects.

9. Head of the Department concerned shall prepare the relevant training materials regarding the schemes under implementation regarding the devolved functions and will undertake capacity building for Panchayat Raj Institutions in these areas in coordination with Andhra Pradesh Academy of Rural Development.

10. Functionaries concerned shall report to the respective Panchayat Raj Institutions in respect of the above devolved functions.

**General Instructions**

11. The Panchayat Raj Institutions are empowered to review, inspect and monitor the institutions and activities of the Social Welfare department. Whenever they inspect an institution and suggest improvements, the authorities of the department concerned in that institution shall be responsible to send an Action Taken Report to those Panchayat Raj Institutions.

12. The Panchayat Raj Institutions shall strive for system improvements and foster better relations between the stakeholders and service departments and take steps to achieve convergence of schemes / activities for filling the gaps in delivery of services efficiently.

13. All existing instructions / rules / orders of the department shall be translated into Telugu and circulate to all elected representatives.

14. Head of the Departments is requested to take necessary action accordingly.

- f. Creation of awareness of Bonded Labour, including Bonded Child Labour

5. The Panchayat Raj Institutions prepare and approve the annual action plan for all plan schemes of the above activities devolved to the Panchayat Raj Institutions. The demarcation among PRIs is mentioned in the Annexure to this order (along with funds).

#### **Release of funds:-**

6.. BROs will be issued from Finance Department in the name of Commissioner, Social Welfare. The funds for activities devolved to PR Institutions, shall be adjusted to the PD Accounts of concerned PR Institutions i.e., Zilla Parishad / Mandal Parishad / Gram Panchayat. These funds shall be utilized under supervision of the Commissioner, Social Welfare.

#### **Accounting and Auditing :-**

7. The Panchayat Raj Institutions shall be responsible for proper utilization, accountability, auditing and reconciliation of the funds transferred to them. PR Institutions shall issue utilization certificate to this department. For this purpose, Government accounting system as detailed in G.O.Ms.No.172, PR&RD (Accts. 1) Department, dated 16-05-2005 will be followed by the PR Institutions in respect of funds released for the devolved activities.

**Capacity building:-**

8. AP Academy of Rural Development will undertake capacity building for PR Institutions for accounting, auditing, reconciliation and other related aspects.
9. Commissioner, Social Welfare, shall prepare the relevant training materials about the schemes under implementation regarding the devolved functions and will undertake capacity building for PR Institutions in these areas in coordination with AP Academy of Rural Development.
10. No functionaries have been proposed to be transferred to the respective Panchayat Raj Institutions in respect of the above devolved functions.

WOMEN DEVELOPMENT, CHILD WELFARE & DISABLED WELFARE (JJ) DEPT.

**G.O.Ms.No. 41**

**Dated the 19<sup>th</sup> November, 2008.**

**ORDER:**

73<sup>rd</sup> Amendment of the Constitution provides for strengthening and revitalizing the Panchayat Raj Institutions so that they can sub-serve the needs of the teeming millions that live in the rural areas. To achieve these objectives 73<sup>rd</sup> Amendment Act has provided for the devolution of powers and responsibilities to Panchayat Raj Institutions to enable them to function as Institutions of Self-Government with respect to;

- a. The preparation of plans for economic development and social justice;
- b. Monitoring and implementation of schemes for economic development and social justice as may be entrusted to them including those in relation to the matters listed in the Eleventh Schedule.

2. Government of Andhra Pradesh have enacted APPR Act 1994 (Act 13 of 1994), reflecting the spirit of the Constitutional mandate. To start with, the Government of Andhra Pradesh have identified 10 core subjects to be devolved to the Panchayat Raj Institutions.

**Functions to be devolved**

3. Government after careful consideration of recommendations of the Task Force headed by the Special Chief Secretary to Government, hereby devolve the powers and functions in respect of subjects relating to Department of Women Development, Child Welfare & Disabled Welfare as detailed below:-

- I. All round development of Women, Children, Disabled and elderly.**
- II. Monitor, review and ensure proper implementation of all Welfare schemes of Women, Children, differently abled and the elderly, including ICDS, Girl Child Protection Scheme, Kishori Shakti Yojana etc., and such other schemes as may be introduced from time to time.**
- III. Monitor and review the functioning of Institutions including Vocational Institutions, State Homes, AWC's, AWTCS & MLTCs, Service Homes, Rescue Homes, Working Homes, Collegiate Homes, Children Homes, Sishuvihars, Sishugruhas, Swadhar Shelter Homes, Old Age Homes etc. under Women Development & Child Welfare Department. Hostels, Homes**

(Contd..2)

**for PH, Aged, Blind and Residential Schools under the Disabled Welfare Dept.; and NGO's receiving grant-in-aid, such that, they maintain the best possible environment and standards and function properly so as to achieve their objectives.**

4. The Panchayat Raj Institutions would prepare and approve the annual action plan for all schemes/activities as devolved to the Panchayat Raj Institutions. The demarcation among Panchayat Raj Institutions is mentioned in the Annexure-I to this order.

**Release of Funds**

5. The funds shall be released as per Annexure-II. Budget Release Orders will be issued from Finance Department in the name of the concerned Head of Department. The funds for activities devolved to Panchayat Raj Institutions shall be adjusted to the PD Accounts of concerned Panchayat Raj Institutions i.e., Zilla Parishad/Mandal Parishad/Gram Panchayat as case may be. The funds meant for the schemes as per Annexure -II shall be released after counter signature of the concerned.

**Accounting and Auditing**

6. The Panchayat Raj Institutions shall be responsible for proper utilization, accountability, auditing and reconciliation of the Funds transferred to them as per Ann-II. Panchayat Raj Institutions concerned shall issue Utilization Certificate to offices as indicated therein. For this purpose, Government accounting system as detailed in G.O.Ms.No.172, PR & RD (Accts-I) Dept dt.16/05/2005 will be followed by the Panchayat Raj Institutions in respect of funds released for the devolved activities.

**Review & Submission of Progress Reports**

7. The Officers/Staff shall submit progress reports to Panchayat Raj Institutions concerned in such formats as may be prescribed by Government/Head of department, as the case may be. (Annexure-III).

**General Instructions**

8. The Zilla Parishads, Mandal Parishads & Gram Panchayats shall exercise such powers and carry out such activities, in such manner as may be entrusted, by the Government, from time to time.

9. The Panchayat Raj Institutions are empowered to review, inspect and monitor the institutions and activities of the Women and Child Welfare department. Whenever they inspect an institution and suggest improvements, the authorities of the department concerned and staff in that institution shall be responsible to send an Action Taken Report to those Panchayat Raj Institutions concerned.

10. The Panchayat Raj Institutions shall strive for system improvements and foster cordial relations between the stakeholders and service departments and take steps to achieve convergence of schemes/activities and other steps as required, in ensuring proper and effective delivery of services.

11. Any misuse or diversion of funds or deviation of prescribed rules, procedures, guidelines in force or as prescribed from time to time entails appropriate action under relevant provisions of Andhra Pradesh Gram Panchayat Act, 1994 and other Laws in force.

12. All existing Rules/Orders of the Department shall be translated into Telugu and circulated to all Panchayat Raj Institutions by concerned Heads of Departments within one month.

13. The Director, Women Development & Child Welfare, Commissioner, Department for the Welfare of Disabled and Senior Citizen's, Hyderabad, Managing Directors of Andhra Pradesh Vikalangula Co-operative Corporation, Andhra Pradesh Women's Co-operative Finance Corporation & Andhra Pradesh Foods shall take further necessary action in the matter.
